# Nelcome to Amelia Island Plantation

Everyone at the Amelia Island Plantation Community Association (AIPCA) hopes you enjoy your stay at Amelia Island Plantation (AIP). The following is a summary of a few important rules to follow for everyone's safety.



Guest passes are issued by Security at the Main Gate. During your stay, please display quest pass prominently on driver's side of vehicle.



Drivers must observe all posted speeds and traffic signs.



- Parking is restricted on parts of Beachwalker Road, which runs parallel to the beach south of the Omni Resort. Where allowed, please follow the "two wheels on/two wheels off" rule.
- **VEHICLES**
- All vehicles not parked in approved places will be cited.



- To operate Island Hoppers/Carts in AIP, you must be 16 or older and have a valid driver's license. Anyone violating this requirement will have Island Hopper/Cart confiscated.
- Island Hoppers/Carts may be operated only on roadways, not on bike/walking trails, golf cart paths or on or across A1A. The A1A Trail running parallel to AIP may not be used by Island Hoppers/Carts.
- All Island Hoppers/Carts not parked in approved places will be cited.



**PEDESTRIANS** & BICYCLISTS

- Pedestrians and bicyclists should use the bike/walking trails. Where trails are not available, bicyclists must keep to the right; pedestrians must walk on the left, facing traffic.
- Bicyclists must yield to pedestrians and obey all traffic signs.
- The A1A Trail running parallel to AIP is only for pedestrians and bicyclists. Please observe stop signs at intersections. The A1A Trail may not be used by Island Hoppers/Carts.

#### **PETS**



Pets must be leashed or harnessed in all common areas, including roads, trails, parks and beaches. Pet quardians must clean up and dispose of all animal waste.

### SKATEBOARDS & SKATES



Skateboards and skates are permitted on roadways and trails, but only when used in a safe and proper manner.

### **FIREWORKS**



No fireworks are permitted, except by professionals engaged by the Omni Resort or Amelia Island Club.
